

License Policy

Journal Transport Problems since 2007 is published as “Open Access”. Beginning from this year, the articles published in the journal are available in addition to the web-page of the journal, also in the Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ) in PDF format. The full text of the articles of the journal are freely available on the journal's website. Users are allowed to read, download, copy, distribute, print, search, or link to the full texts of the articles in this journal without asking prior permission from the publisher or the author. This is in accordance with the BOAI definition of open access.

The articles in journals are published under Creative Commons licenses (CC BY 4.0). These provide an industry-standard framework to support easy re-use of open access material. Under Creative Commons, authors retain copyright of their work.

By submitting an article to the journal authors agree with the license policy of the editorial board. The signing of the additional documents is not required.

The journal allows the authors to hold the copyright without restrictions. The journal will allow the authors to retain publishing rights without restrictions.

Publisher copyright policies and self-archiving are defined as “green color” in SHERPA/RoMEO.
